

So with gratitude, we lift our voices with those on earth and those in heaven saying:

Sanctus

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

On the night he was betrayed, Jesus took bread; said the blessing, broke the bread and said, "Take, eat: this is my Body, which is given for you. Whenever you do this, remember me." After supper, Jesus took the cup; gave thanks, and said: "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood given for you. Whenever you do this, remember me."

By this holy bread and wine, we remember his sacrifice and proclaim his resurrection, until he comes again.

Celebrating and remembering your love for us, we bring you these gifts, O God. Send your Holy Spirit to make them be for us the Body and Blood of Jesus. Gather us together and make us living examples of him. Through Christ and with Christ and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, to you be honor, glory and praise, now and for ever. **AMEN**.

And now as our Savior Christ has taught us, we pray:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.
