# **TENEBRAE**



Watching with Christ in the darkness and shadows, while he prepares to suffer for the sake of the world.

### About this service:

The name Tenebrae (the Latin word for "darkness" or "shadows") has for centuries been applied to the ancient monastic night and early morning services (Matins and Lauds) of the last three days of Holy Week, which in medieval times came to be celebrated on the preceding evenings. So one might imagine that we gather as monks have for centuries during the dark of the night and the early morning, to reflect and anticipate Christ's suffering for our world.

The most conspicuous feature of the service is the gradual extinguishing of candles and other lights in the church until only a single candle, considered a symbol of our Lord, remains. Toward the end of the service this candle is hidden, typifying the apparent victory of the forces of evil. At the very end, a loud noise is made, symbolizing the earthquake at the time of the resurrection (Matthew 28:2), the hidden candle is restored to its place, and by its light all depart in silence.

By drawing upon material from each of the former three offices of Tenebrae (the monastic services read during darkness) this service provides an extended meditation upon, and a prelude to, the events in our Lord's life between the Last Supper and the Resurrection.

# Part One

#### Psalm 69: 16-23

- Save me from the mire; do not let me sink; let me be rescued from those who hate me and out of the deep waters.

- Answer me, O LORD, for your love is kind; in your great compassion, turn to me."



Leader: The chief priests gathered before Pilate, and petitioned him:



#### Psalm 90

- My soul clings to you; your right hand holds me fast.


