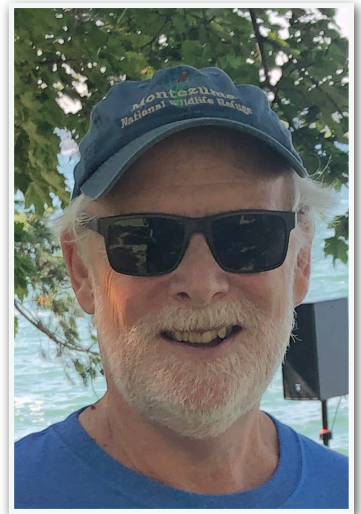
Let's Celebrate Our Friend Jim O'Neill Sunday September 11 @ 10:45am!

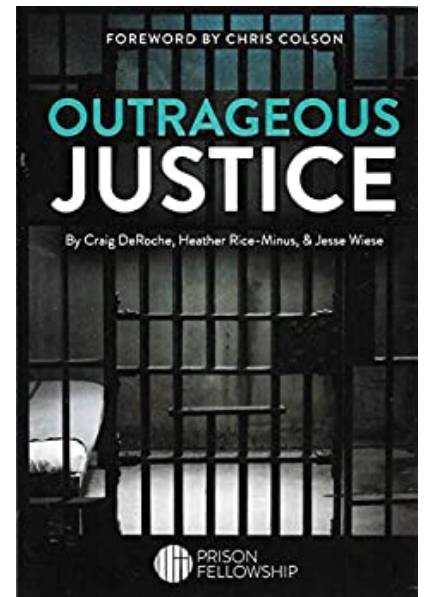

Outrageous Justice Program Returns in the Fall

In May 2022, Ellen Kulik and Cindy Bright facilitated a book study/discussion group using the Outrageous Justice program which was created by Prison Fellowship. It was an eye opening, yet balanced, look at life in American Prisons, the recent history and struggles of our criminal justice system and how St. James may be called to respond to it. The 10 parishioners who participated in the study had a favorable experience and suggested that it be repeated this fall.
